


Urine Cup Procedure Guide






1 Remove the cup with its key from the sealed pouch and use it as soon as possible.



Donor provides a urine specimen in the cup. If the Operator wishes to run the test at a later time, they should remove the key from the cap and hold on to it. Note: The temperature strip should still be read 2-4 minutes after sample collection.




3 Donor dates and initials body label and the security seal. The Operator should check the cap for tightness and attach the security seal.



Donor screws the key clockwise for 180°, and start the timer immediately.



Remove the peel-off label.




6 Check the urine temperature at 2-4 minutes after specimen collection. A green color will appear to indicate the temperature of the urine specimen.



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7 For the adulteration tests, read results by visually comparing the reacted color blocks on the strip with the color card, and the results should be read at 2 minutes, do not interpret the result after 5 minutes.



B Drug test results are indicated by the presence or absence of colored band(s) in the result area. The result should be read at 5 minutes. Do not interpret the result after 10 minutes.





9 Positive test results must be confirmed by another test method. Send the cup and urine specimen intact to a toxicology laboratory for confirmation.
